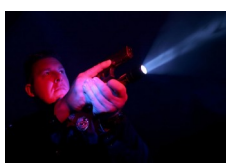

CQB SHOOT HOUSE COURSE



This course is not for rookie shooters. You should already have had prior training with CTIA or similar. This is a dynamic and demanding 10 hour course. It is intended for the average citizen who is interested in learning how to operate inside a linear structure such as your home or business. Police, security and military personnel can also benefit from it. Training topics will include:

- Introduction to room clearing techniques
- Basics of stealth and dynamic entries
- Clearing under stress
- Individual & partner tactics
- Team member rescues
- Tripwire, step line devices detection
- Silent communications & hand signals
- Dynamic drills using handguns and long guns (full auto and SMGs are welcomed)
- Tactically moving within a crowd & engaging various targets
- Shoot/don't shoot drills and exercise
- Shooting while in motion (running, walking), and at moving targets
- Weapons retention and disarmament
- Force on force exercises

Course Instructors: Local SWAT and or former military special operations personnel

Equipment needed: A handgun and a long gun (either rifle or shotgun), holster, 3 mags for each weapon minimum. Full gear list attached.
